The table below show member so the parish who applied to emigrate to Australia in 1851. The list shows those parishioners who were accepted and emigrated, those who were accepted then declined to trave and those who were declined passage

The Marion actually sailed from Plymouth on the 24th March 1851 although other records state that the ship sailed on the 18th March. This may have been the date the ship sailed from London to Plymouth. The ship arrived in Adelaide, South Australia on 29th July 1851. There were six deaths on board and nine births during the voyage. The deaths included one adult, four children under fourteen years of age and an infant. From the births there is to be deducted also one infant child who died shortly after being brought on shore on the morning of disembarkation.
