There were great rejoicings amongst the laboring population at Aldbourne last week in celebration of the marriage of Mr. W. Chandler of North Farm with Miss Puckridge. On the return of the newly-wedded pair from their tour, almost Mr. C.'s first act was to invite about 40 men, women and boys to a substantial dinner, after which the party proceeded to the "Green," where four barrels of beer were distributed amongst the labourers present (between 2 and 300). This was followed by a merry dance. And on Thursday evening a tea was given to all the younger children of the labourers by Miss Chandler at North Farm.
