On Tuesday, as the son of Mr. William Windsor, farmer, of Alderbury, was riding in his father's waggon to this city, without any one on foot to take care of the horses, they took fright soon after they had passed Petersfinger Gate, when Mr. Windsor jumping out, his frock caught and threw him under the wheels, by which one of his thighs was broken, and he was otherwise very much bruised.
