**1801**

**Death** - On Tuesday last as Robert Rawlings, an industrious man belonging to the Earldoms, who supported himself by the carriage of fire-wood, &c. from the New Forest, was driving his waggon from thence to Winchester, in coming down Alderbury Shoot, he observed something out of place near the wheels, and unfortunately endeavouring to get it to rights, without stopping the horses, the streak caught his smock frock, and dragged him under the wheels, by which he was so much bruised that he died in about four hours after. **Oxford Journal Saturday 26 September 1801**

**1803**

**Death** - Last week died Mrs Reeves, of the Green Dragon, Alderbury. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 25 April 1803**

**1812**

**Marriage** - On Thursday was married, at Alderbury, by the Rev Thomas Fox, of Mapperton, Dorset, the Rev Thomas Fox, of Fovant, to Mary eldest daughter of the late George Yalden Fort, Esq. of Alderbury House. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 7 December 1812**

**1813**

**Marriage** - On Tuesday last, at Alderbury, Wilts, the Rev Edward Duke, of Lake-House, in that county, to Harriet, youngest daughter of Henry Hinxman, Esq. Of Ivy Church, near Salisbury. **Cheltenham Chronicle Thursday 28th January 1813**

**1815**

**Death** - On the evening of Saturday the 28th ult. about seven o'clock, as Mr W Geterell and his son, a little boy, were returning from Alderbury to Longford Castle, near this city, in passing a narrow bridge across the river, Mr G's foot slipped, when he fell into the river, and was unfortunately drowned; his body had not yet been found. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 6 February 1815**

**Death** - On Wednesday last died, in the 76th year of his age, Mr Richard Simmonds, formerly a respectable butcher, of Alderbury, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 15 May 1815**

**Death** - On Thursday last died, at the advanced age of 93 years, Mr William Lawrence, of Alderbury, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 15 May 1815**

**Death** - On Sunday the 28th of May died, aged 90 years, Mr Wm Lawrence, of Alderbury, near this city. Mr L's death was stated some weeks since in this journal, by a mistake arising from his extreme illness. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 5 June 1815**

**Marriage** - On Monday last was married, at Alderbury, Mr George Keene, of Stroud Water, Gloucestershire, to Miss Harriet Morris, of Whaddon, and late of the city of Hereford. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 9 June 1817**

**Marriage** - On Thursday last was married, at Alderbury, Mr Aaron Foster, of Clarendon Park, to Miss Letitia Bungey, of Alderbury. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 9 June 1817**

**Marriage** - On Monday the 27th of October was married at St George's, Hanover Square, London, Mr Wm Carpenter, bookseller, of Bond Street, to Margaret, second daughter of Mr Geddes, of Alderbury Cottage, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 17 November 1817**

**Death** - On Monday last died, after a lingering illness, Mr William Windsor, many years bailiff to George Fort Esq of Alderbury House, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 24 November 1817**

**Marriage** - At Tetbury, Gloucestershire, the Rev Hugh Stevens, BD, Vicar of Alderbury, &c. to Miss Sophia Cripps, fifth daughter and co-heiress of the late John Cripps, Esq. of Upton House. **Hereford Journal Wednesday 2 September 1818**

**1819**

**Death** - On Thursday last died, at her house in Milford-street, in this city, aged 59, Mary, widow of George Yalden Fort, Esq late of Alderbury House, in this county. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 22 March 1819**

**1820**

**Marriage** - On Wednesday the 18th inst was married at Britford, by the Rev Mr Morres, Mr John Hardyman, of the Green Dragon, Alderbury, to Fanny, eldest Daughter of Mr William Elkins, of Nunton. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 30 October 1820**

**1821**

**Death** - Tuesday the 29th ult. Died, George Thomas, the infant son of George Fort, Esq, of Alderbury House in this county. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 4 June 1821**

**Death** - On Monday last died, at an advanced age, Mrs Lawrence, widow of Mr. John Lawrence, of Alderbury, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 12 November 1821**

**1822**

**Death** - On Saturday the 24 ult., died at Alderbury, near this city, aged 68 years, Mr. John Jefferies, formerly of the Green Dragon Inn, of that place. Though humble his walk through life, his generous and contented disposition was an example to those in a more exalted station. He lived respected and died regretted. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 2 September 1822**

**Marriage** - Lately was married at the Episcopal Chapel, Edinburgh, by the Rev. J. Allison, Wm. Ins, Esq, BA of New Cavendish Street, London, to Harriet, eldest daughter of Mr Geddes, of Alderbury Cottage, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 14 October 1822**

**1824**

**Marriage** - On Sunday the 12th inst. was married, at the Cathedral Church, Mr. Thomas Burt, of Clarendon Park, to Miss Priscilla Cooke, of Alderbury, youngest daughter of Mr. Cooke, of West Grimstead. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 20 September 1824**

**1825**

**Marriage** - On Thursday the 20th inst. was married at Alderbury Church, in this county, Mr. William Liddell, gamekeeper to the Right Hon. the Earl of Radnor, to Miss Mary Ann Smith, housekeeper to the Right Rev. Lord Bishop of Elphin, now residing at Southampton. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 24 October 1825**

**1827**

**Death** - Saturday night, Mr. Prewit, of Alderbury, in consequence of his having been exposed to the storm during the night of Britford fair. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 25 January 1827**

**Death** - On Saturday the 24th ult., died after a long illness, aged 48, Mrs. Lawrence, wife of Mr. John Lawrence, maltster, West Harnham, formerly of Alderbury. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 5 March 1827**

**1828**

On the 1st inst. died, at the Vicarage, Alderbury, in this county, at the advanced age of 85 years, universally respected, Mrs Smith, relict of the Rev Ralph Smith, late Rector of Oaksey, in the county of Wilts. **Oxford Journal Saturday 24 May 1828**

**1829**

**Death** - On Tuesday last, Henry Hinxman, esq, of Ivey Church, Alderbury, at the advanced age of 82 years. He was the oldest member of the corporation of Salisbury, and for many years an alderman and magistrate. When chief Magistrate he filled the office with becoming dignity, leaving behind him the character of an able, upright, and impartial public officer. In the more private walks of life, he was universally esteemed for the warmth of his affections, the ardour and sincerity of his friendship, and the extended benevolence of his heart. He has left a widow, one son, and two daughters, to deplore his loss; the former is a clergyman of distinguished ability in the church, the eldest of his daughters is married to Mr. Rachleigh, late member of the House of Commons; and the other to the Rev. Mr. Duke, of Lake, one of the magistrates of the county. Mr Hinxman was uncle to Edward Hinxman, esq, of Dornford House. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 4 June 1829**

**Marriage** - Married, on Thursday, at Alderbury, by the Rev. Hugh Stevens, Mr. James Morris, of Whiteparish, to Mrs Elizabeth Windsor, relict of the late much-esteemed Mr. William Windsor. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 16 May 1831**

**1832**

**Marriage** - July 10, at Alderbury, Mr. G. Evans, of Devizes, to Miss Hutchins, of Longstock, Hants. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 19 July 1832**

**1834**

**Marriage** - Married a few days since, at Alderbury, Mr. Samuel Gumbleton, jun., of Grimstead, to Miss Elizabeth Porton, of the former place. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 19 May 1834**

**1835**

**Death** - Died, on Thursday last, at Alderbury, near this city, Mr Isaac Sopp. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 20 April 1835**

**Death** - Died, on Wednesday last, after a long illness, at Alderbury, where she resided for the benefit of her health, Mrs. Richardson, wife of Mr John Richardson, grocer, of Winchester Street in this city, leaving a young family to deplore their loss. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 1 June 1835**

**Marriage** - Married, on the 11th inst., at Winterslow, by the Rev. Chancellor Marsh, Abraham Lewis, of Alderbury, to Miss Mary Leach, of Whaddon. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 13 July 1835**

**1836**

**Marriage** - Married, at Alderbury, on Tuesday, the 19th inst., by the Rev Charles Barter Sweet, William Leyland Woods, Esq., of Chilgrove, Sussex, to Mary Anne, eldest daughter of George Fort, Esq, of Alderbury House, in this county. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 25 July 1836**

**1838**

**Marriage** - Dec 2, at the Cathedral, Salisbury, Mr. Gartary, eldest son of Mr. Gartary, of Alderbury, to Miss Bunday, eldest daughter of Mr. Bunday, of Clarendon Park **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 13 December 1838**

**Death** - Died, at Alderbury, on the 18th inst., Mrs. Martha Snook, aged 72 years, many years a respected domestic in the service of the late Valden George Fort, Esq. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 24 December 1838**

**1840**

**Death** - Died, on Tuesday, the 12th inst., at Alderbury House, in this county, Mary Charlotte, the infant daughter of Leyland Woods, Esq., of Chilgrove, in the county of Sussex. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 18 May 1840**

**Death** - Died, on Thursday, the 11th inst., at the house of her sister, Mrs. Geddes, at Alderbury, Mrs. Mary Davis, in her 80th year. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 22 June 1840**
