**Pewsey Sessions.** Mary Ann Andrews, of Pewsey, single woman, was brought up in custody under remand, charged with stealing a pair of woman's boots, value 1s. 6d., at Alton Priors, on the 27th ult., the property of Elizabeth Odey, wife of Thomas Odey, of Alton Priors, labourer. The complainant said that, knowing the prisoner, she boarded and lodged her for five days, and shortly after she had left her house she missed her boots, and found prisoner's old ones, a much worn pair, left in place of them.
