



The Antrobus Family of Amesbury

Cosmo Gordon Antrobus

Sir Cosmo Gordon Antrobus, Bt., sat on the Amesbury parish council between 1921 and 1924.

Edmund Antrobus

A Lieutenant with the 4th Company, 1st Battalion Grenadier Guards and was killed in action on the 24th October 1914, aged 27. He has no known grave and is commemorated on the Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial at Ieper, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium. His name is inscribed on panels 9 and 11. He was the only son of Sir Edmund Antrobus, 4th Bart, of Antrobus, Cheshire.

Edmund Antrobus

Colonel Sir Edmund Antrobus was buried in Amesbury Churchyard on the 15th February 1915 just under 4 months after losing his only son in October of 1914 at the Battle of Ypres from which it was said the Colonel never recovered.
