



Summons Against Driver Dismissed

Magistrates at Salisbury County Petty Sessions on Tuesday dismissed a summons for driving a motor car without due care and attention preferred against Ernest Mundy (51), carpenter and joiner, of Camford, London Road, Amesbury.

The case was stated to have arisen from an accident at Folly Bottom cross-roads on the Amesbury-Andover road at 4.20 p.m. on January 4. Another motorist was alleged to have been about to pass the junction when defendant emerged with the result that the other driver swerved, collided with a low wall and overturned.

In evidence Mundy said he complied with the halt sign and was stationary while several vehicles passed by - he imagined for a minute to a minute and a half.
