Mr. Whitmarsh held an inquest at Ansty on the body of John Bowels, a lad about nine years old who, whilst gathering acorns on a tree, fell from thence to the ground. Recourse was had to medical assistance but in vain. Verdict: Accidentally killed by falling from a tree.
