

Obituary of Henry William Steele

The death occurred at Salisbury Infirmary recently of Mr. Henry William Steele, at the age of 41. Deceased was employed as a painter by the Wilts County Council. He was a member of the Home Guard and Ansty Band. His loss is regretted by all his comrades and friends.
