Rector Nominated Owing to the fact that Lord Arundell of Wardour, the patron of the benefice of Ansty - which is a donative - is a Roman Catholic, the right of donation to it, on vacancy, lapsed to the University of Oxford under the Roman Catholic Presentation Acts. Due notice having been given, the Rev. Quartus Bacon, M.A., St John's College, Oxford, who since 1893 has been curate of Atworth, was nominated by the Bishop of Salisbury, and a Fellow and graduate of St John's College has been formally elected to the4 living.
