Killed in the Battle of Mons, Aug, 24th 1914 Aged 30 Years “For me to live is Christ and to die is gain” Also of Mary the beloved wife of William Thomas Webb who passed away Sep. 23rd 1926, Aged 66 years. “He giveth his beloved sleep” Also of William Thomas Webb died Sept. 15th 1935, Aged 78, “At Rest”.</p>

Bushell	George Edward	<p style="text-align: center;">To the Glory of God Sacred to the memory of GEORGE EDWARD BUSHELL, aged 27 Died of Fever at Ladybrand Aug 26th 1900 also of Charles William Daniell aged 21 Died of fever at Harrismith Jan^{ry} 9th 1901 Both of the 2nd Co. Wilts Imp Yeomanry who volunteered for service in S. Africa. This Tablet is erected by friends and Parishioners “For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again” Even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with Him”</p>
Sloper	Victor Frederick	<p style="text-align: center;">To the Glory of God and In loving memory of 2nd Lt. VICTOR FREDERICK SLOPER of the 4th Battn. Wilts Regt. (formerlt Sergt. In the Royal Wilts Yeomry) Aged 30 years He lost his Life in the service of His Country By being torpedoed on board S.S. Leinster in the Irish Sea October 10th 1918. His body is interred in this churchyard He was Sidesman of this Church for 12 years</p>
