## Fricker Monument in Churchyard of Church of St. Edith

## (about 3 Metres South East of Chancel)

Location - Churchyard, about 3 Metres South East of Chancel of St. Edith's Church at Baverstock, near Dinton.

Grade II - Listed 17 December, 1986

Chest tomb. Early C17. Limestone tomb with plain inscription panels and heavy chamfered top, good incised lettering on south side to Walter Fricker died 1625 and to Jane, his wife died 1634.
