In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Light of Bemerton in the County of Wilts Gentleman being inform in body but of sound and disposing Mind Memory and Understanding thanks be given to Almighty God therefore do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say ffirst I do give and bequeath unto my loving Wife Margaret all my Household Goods for her Life only and after her decease I do give and bequeath all my said Household Goods to my Son Thomas Light and Daughter Mary Hussey to be divided equally between them also I do give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife Margaret all my Linnen Plate and Rings for her Life only and after her decease I do give and bequeath all the said Linnen Plate and Rings unto my Children or Grand Children as shall be living at the time of her death in such manner and by such proportions as my said Wife by any Writing under her hand shall direct and appoint Also I do give and bequeath unto my said Loving Wife Margaret One hundred Pounds to be paid in three Months after my decease Also I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Hussey ne hundred pounds to be paid in six Months after my decease Also I do give and bequeath unto my Grand Children Thomas and Mary Hussey to each of them ffifty pounds to be paid at their respective Age or ages of Twenty One Years or day of Marriage which shall first happen Also all the Rest and Residue of my Goods Chattels Rights and Credits whatsoever not herby otherwise disposed of after my Debts

Legacyes and ffuneral Expences are paid and discharged I do give and bequeath unto my said Son Thomas Light whom I do hereby nominate and appoint full and sole Executor of this my Will hereby revoking all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereto set my Hand and Seal the Eighth day of July in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and forty five \_ *Tho Light*
