In the name of God Amen The five and twentieth day of June in the yere of our Lord God one thousand five hundred fower score six I Alice Vivashe widowe of the parrishe of Bishopps Canninge sick in bodie and yet thanks be unto Almighty God of good and perfect memory and remembrance do ordayne and make this my last will and testament in manner and forme following Ffirst I bequeathe my soule unto Allmightie God my only redeemer and saviour and will that my bodie be buryed in the parrishe church of Bishopps Canninge by my husbande Item I give unto our Ladie Church of Sarum one pound five shillings Item I give to the the reparacon of my parrish church ten pounds Item I give and bequeathe to Margerie my daughter ten acres of wheate and six acres of barley Item I give to Jane my daughter ten acres of wheate and six acres of barle Item I give to Richard Sloper Senior one acre of barley Item I give to Robert Nashe Senior one acre of barley Item I give to Thomas Barrett one acre of barley Item I give to Jane Jakes one acre of barley Item I give to Margerie Nashe one acre of barley Item I give to Alice Lewys my goddaughter ten pounds Item I give to Margerie Carver my goddaughter ten pounds Item I give to Jane Ashley my goddaughter ten pounds Item I give to Robert Dalymer my godsonne ten pounds Item I give to William Smyth Clerk one half acre of peason Item I give and bequeath unto Margerie my daughter feather bed which I lye uppon Item I give and bequesth to Jane my daughter one feather bolster one peyre of sheets and one coverlet one pillow staye and one coffer Item I give to Margerie my daughter one pillow staye Item I give and bequeath to Alice Vivashe my goddaughter my bigger sowe pigge Item I give to Jane my daughter my bigger brass pan Item I give to every one of my servants ten pounds a peece Moreover if it chance either of my two daughters Margerie and Jane to dye before one or other being unmarryed then my will is that the deceased's stock remayne to the longer lyver of them The rest of my goods moveable and unmoveable my debts payed I give and bequesth unto Edward my sonne whom I make my sole executor of this my last will and testament Furthermore I desire Richard Sloper Robert Nashe and Thomas Barrett to be my overseers of this my last will and testament and to see my legacies equallie divided amongst them and that my two daughters' legacies be put further for their profit until they be marryed by the discrecon of my overseers
