



Funeral of Frank Povey 1941

The funeral took place on Saturday at St. Mary's Church, of Mr. Frank Povey, second son of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Povey. The service was conducted by the Rev. E.W. Smith (Vicar).

Mr Povey, who would have been 74 years of age this month [died 5 March], was well known having resided in the village nearly all his life.
