



*War Graves Located in
St. Aldhelm's Churchyard, Bishopstrow*

George Robert Colvin Atwood, Office Cadet 931997, Royal Artillery, died 25th October 1941, age 20, son of Commander George Evelyn Laverton Atwood, R.N. and Madeline Elizabeth Atwood of East Tisbury; his sister Helen Pamela Atwood also died whilst on war service. She was a Section Officer with the Women's Auxiliary Air Force and died on 13th June 1944 age 26. She is buried in Grave 18B of Kinclaven Churchyard, Perthshire.



Thomas Hulkes Bingham-Day, Lt. Col. 5th Battalion Devonshire Regiment, died 11th April 1917, age 62 and is buried in the south part of the churchyard. He was the son of Thomas Hermitage & Emma Day of Frindsbury, Rochester, Kent; husband of Katherine Margaret Bingham-Day. Thomas also served in the South African Campaign.
