The Nuncupative Will of John Gould otherwise Hawkins of Bower chalke in the County of Wilts husbandman who dyed on or about the first Day of September one thousand six hundred fifty eight I give and bequeath unto my Sonne John twenty shillings, and twenty shillings more unto his wife, and twenty shillings apiece more unto my Sonne John's children and the residue of my goods I give unto my wife whom I make my Sole Executrix and Doe alsoe give unto my sd wife my house to have and to hold unto her Dureing her life, the remainder unto my Sonne Thomas Witnes Hugh Gould his marke, Mary Shergold her marke, *Thomas Gould*
