Hic jacet GEORGIUS SPEKE Barnonettus filius HUGONIS SPEKE Baronetti de HASELBURY in Comitatu WILTON ANNÆQ filiæ unicæ et Hæredis IOHANNIS MAYNE Armigeri de STEPLEHURST in Comitatu CANTIJ natus die Octobris anno Dm. MDCLIII Denatus XIV die Ianuarij änno Dni. MDCLXXXII
