Notes or Further Information

Hubert was the son of Walter & Louisa H. Applegate (nee Peachy) of the Rise, Newtown, Bradford-on-Avon. He was baptised on the 3rd May 1895 in Bradford-on-Avon. From May 1906 to April 1910 he attended the Downs School, Clifton, Bristol. The 1911 census shows him as living with his widowed mother, two sisters and maternal uncle in Willesden, Middlesex. From August 1914 to July 1915 Hubert

was a Technical Assistant in the Physical Laboratory at Wolseley Motors, Adderley Park. From July 1915 until May 1918 he was in charge of special experimental tests of aero engines at Wolseley. At age 23 he was serving with the RAF as a Marine Observer 177514, his service commencing on the 13th May 1918 until February 1919. In 1920 he married Mabel L. Margerand in Willesden, Middlesex. On the 14th April 1920 Hubert was admitted to the Institution of Automobile Engineers as an Associate Member, stating his business address as the Experimental Department, Wolseley Motors Ltd., Adderley Park, Birmingham. His home address was Hillcroft, Abbey End, Kenilworth. Hubert Frederick died on the 22nd January 1986 aged 91, he was resident at Cale Green Nursing Home, Adswood Lane, West Stockport. Probate was granted at Manchester on 14th March 1986 the estate not exceeding £40000.
