In H.M. 22nd Light Dragoons, fell a Victim to the Cholera-Morbus, which so fatally ravaged the British Camps in India, in the Pindaree-War; on the 19th of May 1819. Aged 30 Years_ On the 17th of the same Month this young Officer in high health and spirits wrote to his friends that the fatal disorder had disappeared from the Camp, _About 7 o,clock in the Morning of the 19th he was himself seized with it, and before Noon he lay a Corpse.</p>
