



Coroners Inquest Reports

Bradford on Avon

Inquest held by George Sylvester, esq. –

At Bradford, on Benjamin Strine, aged 29 years. The deceased was assisted on Saturday evening last towards his home by his wife and another person, in a state of inebriation, he was left lying on the road leading to Newtown, and on the following morning was discovered to have fallen 10 or 12 feet down an area at the back of a house near. He was conveyed home in a state of collapse and paralysis of the extremities arising from an injury of the spinal marrow; he died the following morning.

Verdict – Accidental Death.
