FATAL ACCIDENT On Monday afternoon last, as Mrs Whitworth of Bremhill was driving her pony carriage to Chippenham, accompanied by her daughter, the pony, on descending Derry Hill took fright, and, darting off at a rapid pace threw both Mrs Whitworth and her daughter into the road; the former of whom was so severely injured as to occasion her death within a few hours afterwards. Miss Whitworth escaped unhurt. Hampshire Advertiser Saturday 4 April 1835
