Bremhíll 1900-1949

1903

Yesterday Herbert Matthews and George Hillier, labourers of Bremhill, Calne, were charged with breaking into the house of George Hawkins, farmer of Bremhill, and stealing £20 in gold, besides silver &c, on the evening of Sunday August 30th. Both defendants were acquitted. Western Daily Press Thursday 22 October 1903

1922

Charles Walter, a labourer of Bremhill, was on Wednesday sentenced to a month hard labour for neglecting to maintain his wife and four children. Defendant, who was arrested at Evesham, disappeared seven years ago, leaving his family to go into the workhouse. During the seven years they had cost the ratepayers £500.
