Inquest on Joseph Brittain

Before Mr Coroner Whitmarsh at Studley in the parish of Bremhill, on the body of Joseph Brittain, 39 years of age, occasioned from a fall on the back of his head, on the road, with his hat off, when returning from the Devizes Militia. Verdict: "Died by compression of the brain, caused by the fall".
