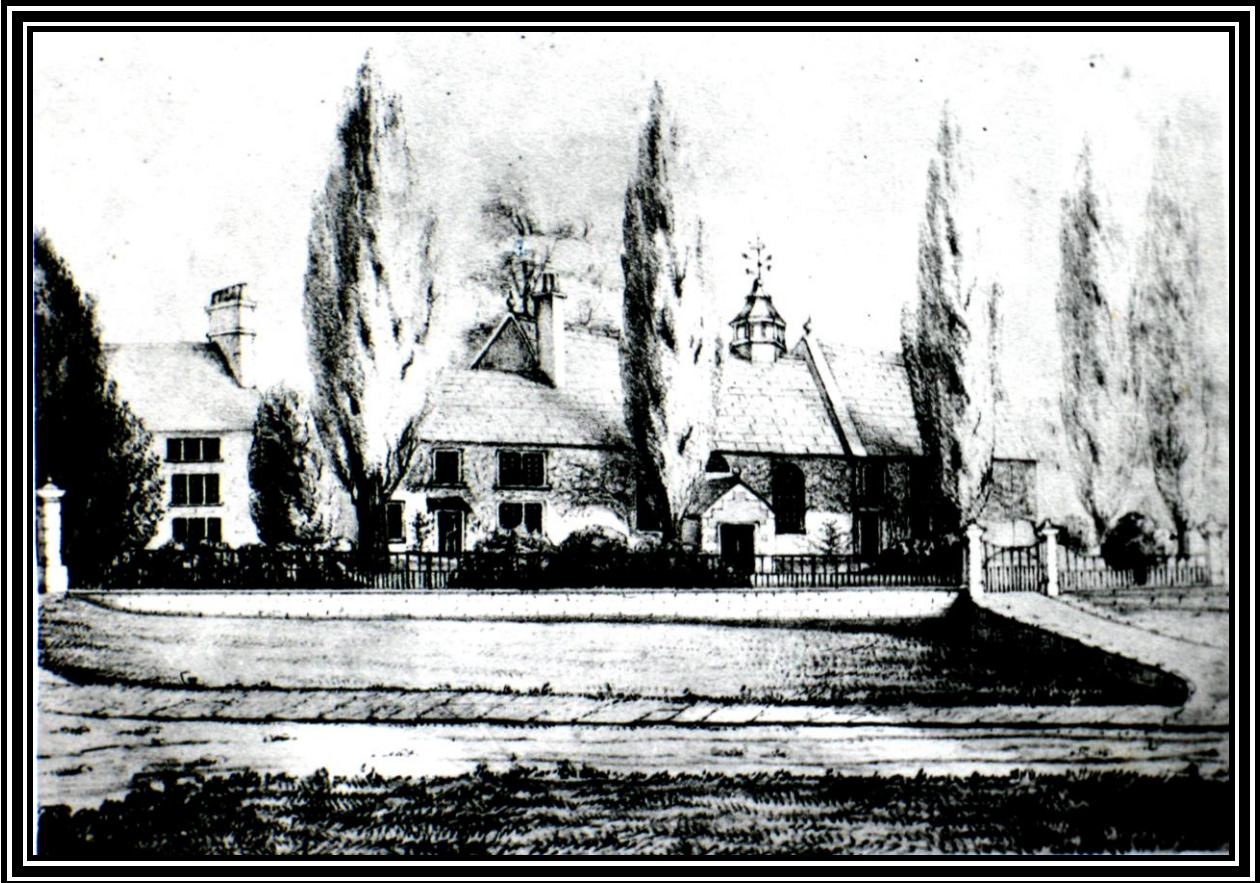
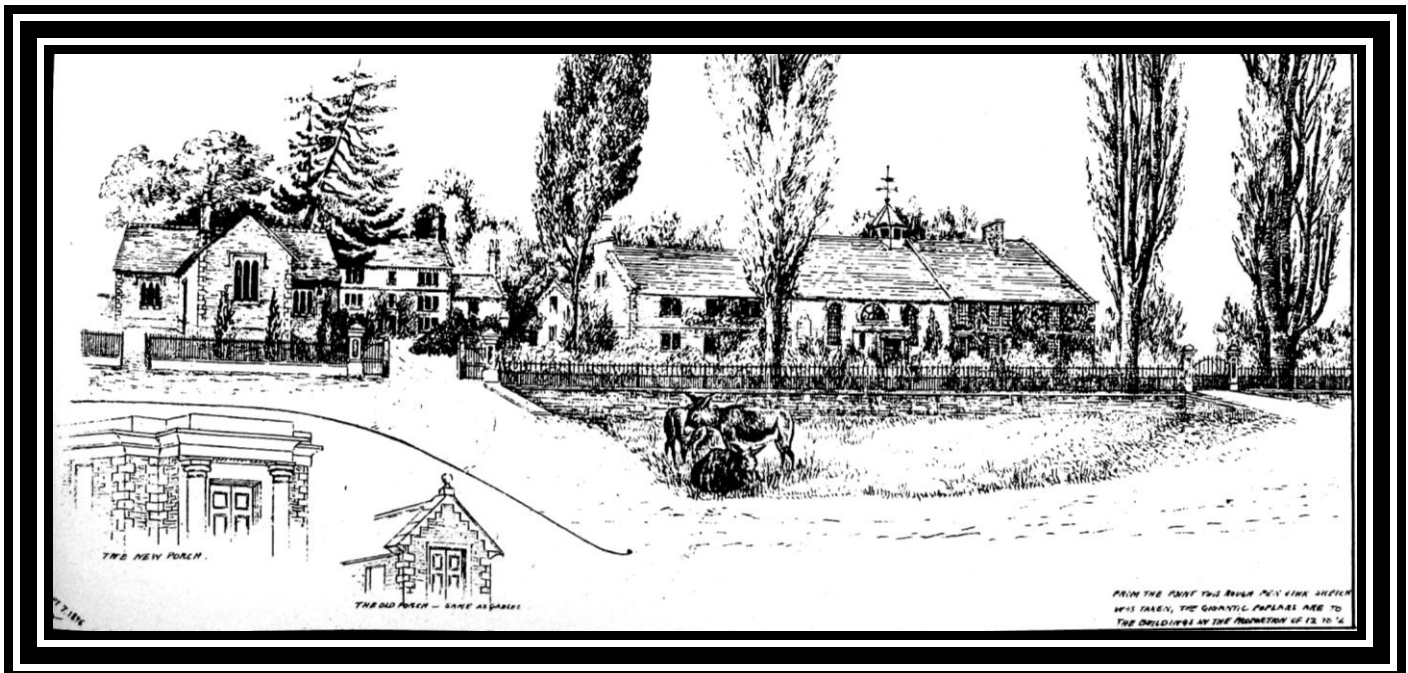

The Moravian Church sometime before 1896. The old gables over the doorway are still in place.



The church in September 1896. Note the gables the pointed arch is now flat – an important feature when dating old photographs of the church, as in the one below



The Moravian Church probably around 1880? This is the oldest photograph of the church presently known



Enlargement, showing the four women and one child in front of the church. Perhaps girls from the Moravian School? Or daughters of a Moravian minister? The girls' clothes are Victorian. But most importantly, for dating, the old (pre-1896) gables on the church are still present.



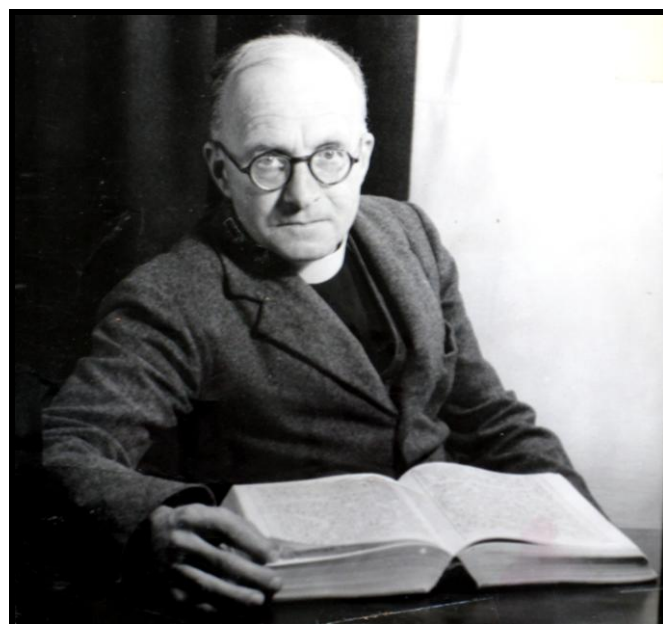
Mrs. Harvey's three children, 1905. The Revd. William Charles Batt was the Moravian Minister at this time. Is a wall being built? The definite date enables us to measure time by the growth of the plants around the church.



The view between the lime trees on the path between the school and the burial ground, looking towards the graveyard. The lime trees show that this is before 1927, when the graveyard was extended into the Orchard. Two limes are still standing, the far one now within the graveyard.

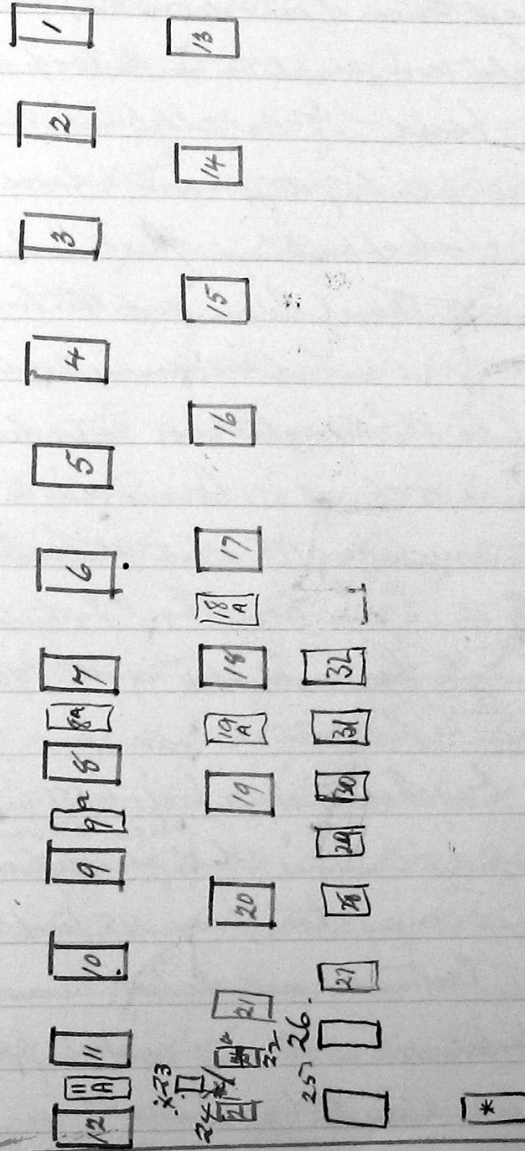
