## **Disturbance at Harnham**

### **Salisbury, County Petty Sessions - Tuesday**

Present: J. H. Jacob, Esq. (Chairman), Earl Nelson, T. E. Fowle, Esq., E. Hinxman, Esq., and A. F. Paxton, Esq.

George Cookman and Reuben Phillips were charged with fighting outside the Swan Inn, at Harnham, early on Sunday morning last. From the evidence of policeman Seymour, it appeared that the defendants had been drinking at the house, and on its being closed at 12 o'clock on Saturday night they commenced fighting in the road. The Bench ordered them to enter into recognisances of £10 each to keep the peace for six months.
