At Bromham, on the body of Drusilla Alexander, an aged woman.

James Outley stated that about eight o'clock in the morning he was passing by her cottage, and the door being open he saw her in the same with her clothes on fire. He put it out and the best assistance was obtained, but she died afterwards from the effects of the burn.

Verdict, "Accidental death."
