I Ann Chowles widow of Burbage in the Countie of Wilts beinge in present understandinge and meorie through gods goodnes doe make and declare this to be my last will and Testament Imprimis I doe make my Kinsman John Tarrant (Sonne to widow Tarrant my Sister in lawe) my sole and whole Executor Item I give unto my Kinsman William Tarrant Blacksmith three pounds in mony a blanket and two platters Item to my Kinswoman Edith Tarrant I give three pounde in mony a box and a Sheete Item I give to Margarett Stratton my kinswoman all my wearinge apparell Item I give and bequeath to William Tompson Junior the five pounde given me by my husband and due to me from Stephen Ed..... of Stockwood in the parish of greate Bedwin Item I desire my Cosen Edmund Tarrant to bee Overseer of this my last will and Testament Ann Chowles her marke Sealed and delivered in the presence of us *Thomas Tayler* Edmund Tarrant his marke
