Mr. Page preached his ninth sermon on the words "Jesus only," last Sunday evening to a large congregation. The preacher said that the sentiment of the words were as clear as ever to him, and he then eloquently shewed that Jesus was pre-eminent above all men, and that men were always and everywhere, in religion, seeking to exalt man beyond his proper sphere. This idea was then applied to "Jesus only," as against the humanitarian system of Strauss, "Jesus only," as against the Popish system, "Jesus only," as against mere sectarianism, and "Jesus only," as the hope of each and all.
