1827

Committed to the House of Correction Devizes Robert Humphries for vagrancy - 1 month
Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 21 June 1827

1833

Committed to the House of Correction, Devizes. Thomas Dyke of Calne for three months, Abraham Rivers of Bremhill for two months, Henry Walter of Shalbourne for six weeks, William Walker of Chiseldon for one month and John Slade of Bremhill for twenty days, for breaches of the game laws. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 31 January 1833**

Committed to the Old Bridewell, Devizes Edward Williams, charged with stealing two books, the property of Edwin Baily, of Calne. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833**

Committed to the Old Bridewell, Devizes William Harper, charged with assaulting Ann Parson, the wife of Joseph Parsons, of Calne, with intent, &c. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833**

1838

Committed To The New Prison, Devizes Thomas Walker, for one month, for destroying a hat, the property of John Gough, at Calne. **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

1839

Committed to the New Prison, Devizes John Ford, for one month, for insubordination in the Union Workhouse at Calne **Devizes & Wiltshire Gazette, 28 February 1839**

1841

Salisbury Assizes George Butler, for stealing a mare and bridle, the property of Mandcell Manners, at Calne, was sentenced to be transported for 15 years. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 8 March 1841**

1843

Andrew Kearton, charged on suspicion of having stolen one smockfrock, eight yards of check cotton, and other articles, the property of John Hedgens, at Calne. Guilty: 7 years transportation. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
