

George and Harríet Wíllíams

- Utah Píoneers

George was the son of Robert and Jane Williams of Wiltshire. He was born October 13, 1828, and came to Utah in 1864, traveling with the Erastus Snow company.

Censuses show:

1841 at Ratsford Bridge, Calne, George, aged 13, with his Barents Robert and Jane Williams, and brothers and sisters.

1851 at Calne, George, 22, a mason born in Christian Malford, with his wife, Harriet, 21, born in Calne.

1861, at Norley Lane, Calne, George Williams, 31, stone mason, with his wife Harriet, 31, and sons, Hyrum, 5, and George E. Roland Williams, 8 months old.

George and Harriet had a total of 6 children:

George Enia born May 22, 1853, died; George Hyrum born July 25, 1855, married Sophia Franson; George Roland born July 31, 1860, married Sarah Burbank October 25, 1883; James Edwin born August 8, 1863, died; Eliza J. (Adline) born September 26, 1865; Eli born September 17, 1869, married Maggie Pope.

They made their family home in Brigham City, Utah.
