

Support of Wife - Thomas Sage

Article appeared in Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette 22nd May 1890

Thomas Sage, of Calne, was summoned to show cause why he should not contribute to the support of his wife who is an inmate of the County Lunatic Asylum. - **Mr. Eattell,** relieving officer, stated that the defendant's wife was admitted into the asylum on the 11th March, as a pauper lunatic. The defendant earned 22s 6d per week and had five children, one of whom earned 3s per week.

The Bench made an order for the defendant to contribute 3s 6d per week
