Dear Sir,

On the 8th February the following articles were sent to the Island of Corfu under the auspices of the Serbian Relief Fund from the Calne War Depot, and we received a letter of grateful thanks from Mrs. Carrington Wilde:- 12 sleeping suits, 12 bed jackets, 12 helpless case shirts, 8 pairs of hospital slippers, 5 dozen roller bandages, 24 many-tailed bandages, 42 knee bandages, 6 bags (each containing 25 mop swabs), 36 dozen square swabs.

Also 9 sleeping suits have been sent to the Calne Red Cross Hospital and gratefully acknowledged by the Commandant and Matron.

We wish to state that our Calne depot has been affiliated to the Surgical Branch of Queen Mary's Needlework Guild, of which the head office is at 2 Cavendish Square. W.
