This is the last Will and Testament of me Samuel Viveash of Calne in the County of Wilts Gentleman I desire my just debts funeral and testamentary expences to be paid by my Exors hereinafter named as soon as convenient after my

decease I give to my Brother Oriel Viveash all that my Paddock or Garden with the Stable and big House near the Almshouses to hold unto my said Brother Oriel his heirs and assigns for ever I give unto my brother Simeon Viveash all my household furniture plate linen and china my wearing apparel and whatever wines beer spirits and liquors may be in my house in which I live at the time of my decease for his absolute use I give to my Niece Eliza Viveash the legacy or sum of two hundred pounds and all my printed books I give to my great Niece Mary Viveash daughter of my Nephew Simeon Viveash the legacy of two hundred pounds to be paid him on his attaining the age of twenty one years and I authorise the Executors either to apply the interest of the said sum of two hundred pounds towards the maintenance and education of my said Great Niece or otherwise suffer the same to accumulate for her benefit until she shall attain the said age of twenty one years I give my Servant Leah Stagg the Legacy or sum of thirty pounds and two suits of mourning if she shall be in my service at the time of my decease And as to all my messuages lands or tenements lands hereditaments and premises and all other my Real and Personal Estate not hereinbefore disposed of I give devise and bequeath the same unto my brothers Oriel Viveash and Simeon Viveash to hold unto them their heirs executors and administrators for ever equally to be divided between them as tenants in common and not as joint tenants And I appoint my said Brothers Executors of this my Will In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my name and seal this third day of ffebruary one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Samuel Viveash
