Bloxham	Mary Jane	Wife of Mr. Henry Bloxam of Aldergate Street, London. Niece of William Fowle Esq. of Chute Lodge, Wilts. Her remains are deposited in a Vault constructed on the South side of the Church by her Aunt Sarah Fowle of Durrington. Died 3rd September 1820, aged 31 – leaving an infant daughter seven months old.
Fowle	Thomas, esq.	Near this church are deposited the remains of Thomas Fowle of Durrington, in this County. Who died February the 3rd 1782, aged 48 years. Henry Fowle esq. of the same Place. Who died May the 16th 1803, aged 67 years. Jane his wife, daughter of Mr. Thomas Springbelt of Wilsford. Who died December the 7th 1780 aged 49 years. Sarah Fowle daughter of Henry Fowle esq. Of Durrington Who died November the 28th 1850, aged 86 years.
Fowle	Thomas Ernle (Colonel)	The 16th Foot. Of Charlton Manor, son of William Fowle of Chute Lodge, who died 21st October 1932, aged 68. Emmeline Voilet his wife, daughter of Frederick Slade-Gully Esq. of Trevennan, Cornwall. Who died 23rd October 1934, aged 67. And Beatrice Fowle his sister who died 12th December 1931, aged 73.
Giffard	Francis	Of Uphaven in this county Who died April 9th 1802 aged 80 years. Bequeathed the interest of 100 L 4 Percent Consolidated Annuities to be distributed in Bread to the Poor of this Parish
Mundy	Sarah	Who died 18 Jany. 1763, aged 43 years.
Pinckney	Charles Heane	Charles Hearne Pinckney of Sudden Park. Who died Feby. 14th 1820, aged 44 years. David Hearne Pinckney of Tidcombe who died Feby. 2th 1820, aged 45 years. Maria Hearne Pinckney of Wolf Hall. Who died June 21st 1831, aged 49 years. George Hearne Pinckney of Wolf Hall. Who died Novr. 10th 1833, aged 49 years.
Pinckney	Robert Hearne	Who on the night of the First of Octr. 1810 was accidentally drowned in the Kennett and Avon Canal. In his Thirtieth year of his age.
Pinckney	Sophia Hearne	Sophia Hearne Pinckney eldest daughter of William Pinckney of Wolf Hall, Esqr. She died at her residence Bath, Decr. 11 1862, aged 82 years. Jane, widow of John Fisher esq. Of Middlesex House, Batheaston and third daughter of William Pinckney esq. of Wolf Hall. Who died at Bath Feby. 27th 1873, aged 86 years.

Pinckney	William	In Vault beneath remains of William Pinckney, died 22nd August 1698 Ann his wife, died 15th Feby. 1709, aged 74 Charles Pinckney (Marshal of the Horse to Queen Anne, and George the 1) died 1st December 1716, aged 48. George Pinckney, died 16th June 1744. Robert Pinckney, died 7th Novr. 1747, aged 83. Martha his wife, died 24th July 1752, aged 76. William Pinckney, died 19th Octr. 1779, aged 68. Sarah his wife, died 15 th March 1756, aged 40.
Price	John, Esq.	(Of Wolf Hall, Burbage, Wilts). Who departed this life 11th Novr. 1837, aged 52 years. Sarah, Widow of the above, who died at Bath 13th Novr. 1879, aged 92 years.
Wansbrough	Alice Martha	Alice Martha Wansbrough, daughter of Henry and Mary Wansbrough Who died May 22 nd 1860, aged 15 years. Mary their infant daughter. Born January 9th died the 14th 1854. Also the above named Henry Wansbrough. Born April 29th 1805, died April 18th 1875. Mary, wife of the above named Henry Wansbrough. Born October 21st 1821, died October 5th 1877. Henry, their only son. Who died October 14th 1896, aged 53.
