Chicklade

James MILLER October, 1860

Taken before George Sylvester, esq, at Chicklade on James Miller, aged 74 years. The deceased resided with Mr Bennett, and occasionally assisted on the farm. On Friday the 12th ult. he went into the barley field and was afterwards found lying on the ground, was conveyed to his house, became insensible, and died shortly after from apoplexy.
