Chicklade

Thomas PORTNALL September, 1867

An inquest was held at the Salisbury Infirmary on the body of Thomas Portnall, upwards of 60 years of age, carrier from Chicklade to Salisbury. The deceased was returning from Salisbury on the 13th ult when his horse began kicking, and the deceased was thrown out, breaking his leg. He was taken to the Infirmary, but gradually sank. The jury returned a verdict of "Accidental Death".
