Died April 13 at Chicklade, John Rogers aged 45.

Died May 14 at Chicklade, Wilts, Susan Clarke. Widow of Mr Charles Clarke Garland. Aged 72.

(Western Gazette - Friday 22 May, 1914)

Died on the 13th inst at E??? suddenly from heart failure, John Halliday of Chicklade House, Wilts, the dearly loved husband of Maria Halliday. Funeral at Chicklade on Wednesday at 2.15 pm.

(Dundee Courier - Wednesday 17 February, 1915)

In loving memory of our dear son and brother, Corporal R. G. Hacker, eldest son of Mr and Mrs W Hacker, Chicklade, who died of wounds received in action at the Battle of Loos, Sept 29th 1915, aged 22. A brave soldier and loving son. He gave his all for his country. God knows how much we miss him, He sees the tears we shed and whispers Hush! He only sleeps, your loved one is not dead.

Shortly after returning from a motoring visit to Bath on Tuesday for shopping, the Duke of Somerset was found dead at his seat, Bradley House, Maiden Bradley, near Frome..... He married, in 1881, Rowena, daughter of the late George Wall of Colombo, Ceylon, and had two sons and a daughter. His heir is Lieut-Col Lord Seymour, DSO OBE, who was born in 1882 and resides at Chicklade House, Hindon near Salisbury.

Died October 29th at Knoyle Down Farm, Hindon, William Warren aged 78. Funeral at Chicklade tomorrow (Saturday) November 1st at 2pm.

(Western Gazette - Friday 31 October, 1941)

Died on November 24th (suddenly) at Chicklade Bottom Farm, Florence beloved wife of Charles Satterly aged 56 years. "Rest in peace".

On May 5th at Seymour's Farm, Chicklade, Agnes Selina Doggrell passed peacefully away (suddenly) aged 65.
