The School Prize Fund

A grand evening concert was given in the National Schoolroom on Tuesday evening by the Misses Halliday of Chicklade.

The programme, which was an excellent one, consisted of songs, violin solos, recitations, duets &c, and there was a very large and appreciative audience.

Miss Gwendoline Halliday was encored for her song, and responded with "II Bacio", which was beautifully rendered. Miss Gwladis Halliday also sang an encore to her song, "A simple bit of string"; and Mr Herbert Bunston to his song "The Keys of Heaven". The recitations of Miss Campbell were all loudly applauded. At the close of the programme a number of photographs of the Jubilee procession, taken by Miss Halliday, were shown, the pictures being illuminated by a powerful oxy-hydrogen light, after which a number of animated photographs were shown by Mr G Pitcher of Tisbury.

The Vicar, the Rev J A Lloyd, on behalf of the managers of the school and those present thanked Mr Halliday and family for the excellent concert they had given, the proceeds of which were for the school prize fund.

Contributions and songs were made by Miss Gwendoline Halliday, Mr H Bunston and Mr J G O Halliday. Miss Gwendoline and Miss Gwladis Halliday and Miss Makins gave a violin, harp and 'cello trio; Miss Gwladis Halliday sang, accompanying herself on the guitar; and Miss Gwendoline Halliday and Miss A K Makins each played violin solos; whilst Miss Campbell recited.
