**GAMESON, ARTHUR ALEXANDER** - Private 20845 - 2nd Battalion South Wales Borderers - died 20th August 1918 - age 31 - enlisted at Ebbw Vale, Monmouthshire; son of John A. and Caroline Gameson of 11 Bourneville Terrace, Tredegar, Monmouthshire; husband of Ellen G. Gameson of 24 London Road, Chippenham; brother of Thomas John Gameson who also gave his life for his country - Buried at Outtersteene Communal Cemetery Extension, Bailleul, Nord, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - II. E. 9 - Commemorated on the Central Memorial, Bedwellty Park, Tredegar, Monmouthshire

**GOULDING, FRANK** - Private 2549 - 7th Battalion Gloucestershire Regiment - died 8th August 1915 at Gallipoli - born in Pinkney, Malmesbury; enlisted at Stroud, Gloucestershire; 3rd son of William and Dorothy Goulding of Pipsmore Cottages, Chippenham; brother of Frederick Orlando Goulding who also gave his life for his country - Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 103 to 104 - Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**GOULDING, FREDERICK ORLANDO** - Private 21701 - 1st Battalion Oxford & Buckinghamshire Light Infantry - died 28th April 1916 in the Persian Gulf - age 22 - enlisted at Chippenham; 5th son of

William and Dorothy Goulding of Pipsmore Cottages, Chippenham; brother of Frank Goulding who also gave his life for his country - Commemorated on the Basra Memorial, Iraq - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 26 and 63 - Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**GRANGER, WILLIAM THOMAS** - Lieutenant - 4th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - died 21st September 1917 of wounds received the day before at Menin Road, Ypres - age 24 - son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Granger of 40 Park Lane, Chippenham - Buried at Bus House Cemetery, Ieper, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference - I. 6 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated in the Memorial Book, St. Paul's Church, Chippenham

**GREGORY, FRANK** - Private 30744 - 1st Battalion Devonshire Regiment - died 30th August 1918 - enlisted at Chippenham - born in Chippenham; enlisted at Chippenham - Commemorated on the Vis-en-Artois Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 4

**GRIFFIN, FRANCIS JOHN** - Private 201006 - 1st/4th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - died 19th September 1918 at Gaza - age 28 - enlisted at Chippenham; son of John and Eliza Griffin of 22 Parliament Street, Chippenham; brother of John Edward Griffin who also gave his life for his country - Buried at Gaza War Cemetery, Israel - Grave/Memorial Reference - XXXII. G. 1. - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**GRIFFIN, JOHN EDWARD** - Private 15294 - 7th Battalion Royal Dublin Fusiliers - died 7th December 1915 - age 36 - enlisted at Devizes; son of John and Eliza Griffin of 22 Parliament Street, Chippenham; brother of Francis John Griffin who also gave his life for his country - Commemorated on the Doiran Memorial, Greece - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the Liberal Club Memorial, Gladstone Road, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**GRIFFITHS, JOHN** - Private 5886 - 1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - died 30th October 1914 - age 32 - born in Malmesbury; enlisted at Devizes; son of John Griffiths of 41 Bostock Avenue, Abingdon, Oxfordshire - Buried at Boulogne Eastern Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - III. A. 21 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HAINES, WALTER FRANK** - Private - Royal Naval Brigade - died 2nd June 1921 of pulmonary tuberculosis - Resident of Nelson's Place, The Causeway, Chippenham - Buried at Chippenham (London Road) Cemetery, Chippenham - Grave/Memorial Reference - Grave/Memorial Reference - 540 Consecrated - Commemorated on the Rood Screen Memorial, St. Andrew's Church, Chippenham - (*This casualty is not recorded by the CWGC since his death is regarded as not having been caused by the effects of war.*)

**HANCOCK, LADAS HARCOURT** - Gunner 71111 - 60th Howitzer Battery, Royal Field Artillery - died 18th April 1916 of wounds - age 21 - Born in Chippenham; enlisted at Bath; resident of Crossbrook Cottages, London Road, Chippenham; brother of Bob Hancock who served aboard HMAS Australia during WWI - Commemorated on the Basra Memorial, Iraq - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 3 and 60 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the Monkton Hill Wesleyan Methodist Church Sunday School Memorial, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HANCOCK, W.** - 1914-1918 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham (*There is no defining criteria to establish the identity of this casualty within the Commonwealth War Grave Commission Registers*)

**HANCOCK, WALTER** - Lance Corporal 8655 - 2nd Battalion (Duke of Edinburgh) Wiltshire Regiment - died 14th October 1914 at Ypres - Born in Chippenham, enlisted at Devizes, resident of Gloucester - Buried at Bedford House Cemetery, Ieper, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference - Enclosure No. 6. IV. D. 9. - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place,

Chippenham; Commemorated on the Tabernacle Congregational Church Memorial, C/O The United Reformed Church, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HAND, ALFRED JOSEPH** - Private 8342 - 2nd Battalion (Duke of Edinburgh) Wiltshire Regiment - died 24th October 1914 - Born in Chippenham, enlisted at Chippenham, resident of Chippenham of 25 Park Lane, Chippenham; son of Mrs. M. L. S. York of 5 St. Mary's Place, Chippenham - Commemorated on the Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, Ieper, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 53. Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HANKS, ERNEST DAVID** - Private 19988 - 5th Battalion Dorsetshire Regiment - died 4th October 1917 age 19 - Born in Great Somerford; enlisted at Devizes; resident of Chippenham; son of Richard and Elizabeth Hanks of 3 Old Road, Chippenham - Buried at Poelcapelle British Cemetery, Langemarke-Poelkapelle, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference - XLVII. D. 10 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated in the Memorial Book, St. Paul's Church, Chippenham

**HARDING, FRANCIS HERBERT** - Private 52477 - 12th Battalion Suffolk Regiment - died 3rd June 1918 of wounds - age 19 - Born in Chippenham, enlisted at Chippenham; son of Mr. G. G Harding of 58 Forest View, Englands, Chippenham - Buried at Cologne Southern Cemetery, Koln, Nordrhein-Westfal, Germany - Grave/Memorial Reference - VII. B. 21. - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HATHERALL/HATHERELL, JOHN HENRY** - Private/Bugler 19542 - 6th Battalion (Duke of Edinburgh) Wiltshire Regiment - died 4th July 1917 of wounds received on 4th June - age 19 - Born in Chippenham; enlisted at Trowbridge; resident of Chippenham; son of John William and Emily Eliza Hatherall of 9 Lowden Hill, Chippenham - Buried at Boulogne Eastern Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - IV. A. 23 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HATHERELL, WILLIAM JAMES** - Private 265919 - 11th Battalion (Prince Albert's) Somerset Light Infantry - 6th November 1918 - age 39 - Born in Chippenham, enlisted at Chippenham; formerly Private 4313 Wiltshire Regiment - Buried at Pecq Communal Cemetery, Pecq, Hainaut, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference - Row F. **HAYES, REGINALD JOHN DICK** - Private 26642 - 15th Battalion Royal Warwickshire Regiment - died 24th August 1918 - Born in Chippenham; enlisted at Chippenham; son of Albert Hayes of Audlee, Lowden Avenue, Chippenham - Buried at Adanac Military Cemetery, Miraumont, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - IV. **HAYWARD, ERNEST VICTOR** - Corporal 15740 - 7th Battalion (Kings) Shropshire Light Infantry - died 2nd June 1917 - age 23 - Born in Hay, Herefordshire; enlisted at Oswestry, Shropshire - son of Thomas and Miriam Hayward of 40 South Broadway Street, Burton on Trent, Staffordshire - Buried at Tilloy British Cemetery, Tilloy-Les-Mofflaines, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - I. D. 2. - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated in the Memorial Book, St. Paul's Church, Chippenham

**HEATH, FRED** - Private PO/17762 - Royal Marine Light Infantry - H.M.S. Britannia Vessel lost off the coast of Gibraltar) - died 9th November 1918 - age 26 - son of Sidney and Kate Heath of West Tytherton, Chippenham - Commemorated on the Portsmouth Naval Memorial, The Esplanade, Southsea, Portsmouth, Hampshire - Grave/Memorial Reference - 30. - Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HEATH, MAURICE GORDON** - Lieutenant Colonel (Commanding) - 2nd Battalion, (Queens) Royal West Surrey Regiment - died 25th September 1915 - age 42 - Mentioned in despatches; formerly 16 years with 1st Battalion Royal West Surrey Regiment; served in the Tirah Expedition (1897-8); served on the North West Frontier of India (1908); son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Walter Brougham Heath of Bessels Green, Sevenoaks, Kent; husband of Edith H. B. Heath (nee Willey) of The Spinney, East Liss, Hampshire - Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 13 to 15.- Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HICKS, HAROLD ALFRED** - Private 95722 - B Battalion, Tank Corps - died 23rd November 1917 - age 22 - born in Long Ashton; enlisted at Bristol; son of Alfred and Jane Ann Hicks of Woodlands, Park Street, Chippenham - Commemorated on the Cambrai Memorial, Louverval, Nord, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 13

**HIGGINS, GILBERT ARTHUR KENNAUGH** - Private 44043 - 9th Battalion Kings Own Yorkshire Light Infantry - died 31st May 1918 - age 21 - Born in Chippenham; enlisted at Chippenham; son of Fitzroy and Laura Higgins of 91, London Road, Chippenham - Buried at Wimereux Communal Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - XI. G. 6. - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the Monkton Hill Wesleyan Methodist Church Sunday School Memorial, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham

**HUNT, PERCIVAL GEORGE HAVELOCK** - Lieutenant - 92 Trench Mortar Battery, Royal Field Artillery - died 8th November 1917 - age 26 - son of George and M. E. Hunt of 24 Langley Road, Chippenham - Buried at Roclincourt Military Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - III. I. - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham; Commemorated on the St. Andrews Church Memorial, Chippenham
