Richard Richardson the younger of Devizes in the County of Wilts Gentleman *John Grant* of Manningford Bruce in the said County Gentleman and *John Blichell* of South Waton in the County of Oxford Gentleman Commissioners appointed in and by an Act of Parliament passed in the Nineteenth Year of the Reign of his Majesty King George the Third Intituled an Act for Dividing Allotting and Inclosing certain Open Common fields Common Pastures and other Commonable Lands Meadows and Waste lands with in the Parish of Chisledon in the County of Wilts
