A Preparatory School for 50 boys between the ages of 6 – 14 years preparing for the Public Schools and the Royal Navy. Five Scholarships to Public Schools have been gained in the last three years.

Greenways is an attractive Georgian house, standing in a park of 60 acres and within ten minutes' walk of a bathing pool. The house faces south.

A thorough grounding is given in all subjects. The curriculum includes Nature Study, Elementary Science, Handwork and Country Dancing. Special encouragement is given to music throughout the school and in addition to singing classes there are flourishing percussion bands and talks on musical appreciation.

Besides swimming, football and cricket, physical and breathing exercises are given daily and gym, once a week. All boys either become Pioneers or Cubs according to age. There is a riding school in the grounds.

Health and Diet receive most careful attention and the domestic arrangements are under the supervision of Mrs Gibbons, assisted by two Matrons. Milk comes from a local farm and is T.T. (certified) from an attested Guernsey herd.

Fees:- 55 guineas a term inclusive
