Codford St. Mary

On the 5th inst. his Lordship instituted the Rev. John William Hammond, Clerk, B.D., to the Rectory of Codford St. Mary, Wilts, vacant by the death of the Rev. George Mountjoy Webster, Clerk, D.D., on the presentation of the President and Scholars of St. John's College, Oxford.

The Rectory of Codford St. Mary had become vacant by the death of the Rev. J. W. Hammond, which occurred on the 13th inst. The living, which is in the gift of St. John's College, Oxford, is stated to be worth £420 per annum.

The Rev. Precentor Lear, as Commissary of the Lord Bishop of Salisbury, has instituted the Rev. David Robert Paramore, clerk, M.A., to the Rectory of Codford St. Mary, Wilts, void by the death of the Rev. John William Hammond, clerk, the last incumbent there, on the presentation of St. John's College, Oxford.
