Henry Charles Sparey 17th March, 1870

INQUESTS:

At Codford St. Peter, on Henry Charles Sparey, aged 7 months. The deceased was found dead by his mother's side on Monday morning: he had chronic hydrocephalus, or accumulation of water on the brain, which by its pressure prevented the nervous energy generated by the brain being transmitted to the heart, which became paralysed.

Verdict – "Natural causes."
