The Lodge, Codford

No. 6 Salisbury Road, Codford, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 11th December, 1987

Cottage orne. Early C19.

Flint nodules with yellow brick dressings, hipped thatched roof with pair of diagonally-set axial brick stacks. Single-storey, polygonal north front with central ogee-headed 6-panelled door, flanking 2-light pointed casements with leaded Y-glazing within verandah on wooden posts. Left and right returns have two similar pointed casements, the rear ones to projecting bays not within verandah. C20 flat-roofed extension not of special interest. Probably built as a lodge to Stockton House (q.v.).
