## **Mother and Infants Drowned**

Bodies Found Near Empty Perambulator

The bodies of Mrs Alice Maud Bray, 41, wife of the foreman of the Roads Department for the Codford District, near Warminster, and her two children, aged eighteen months and nine months, were found in the water near Sherrington mill stream about 8 a.m. yesterday.

Mrs Bray, who lodged with her husband at the village hotel, left the house about 7 o'clock on Sunday evening with her two children in a perambulator. As she did not return a search was made. The perambulator was first found, and in the water near by were seen the three bodies. The woman was clasping her youngest in her arms. A note was found in the perambulator.
