



Ann Thring Memorial

_______the remains of ANN THRING his widow ______daughter of JOHN INGRAM formerly of this Parish. Gent. A rational piety, equally removed from indiscreet zeal, and uninterested lukewarmness, pervaded all her actions, and exemplified the real Christian. Her charities were habitual, and in proportion to her means, truly liberal and diffusive. She retained to the last, in the ninety sixth year of her age, the perfect possession of her intellectual faculties; and continued to endear herself to the society of those around her, by an unvaried serenity, and cheerfulness of temper. In *"the hell assurance of hope unto the end."* She expired on the twenty second day of April A.D. 1824
