Collingbourne Kingston

Miss Elizabeth Piper

Probate of the will, dated the 5th November, 1889, with codicils made the 21st June, 1880, and the 11th June 1887, of the late Miss Elizabeth Piper, of Highfield Lodge, Collingbourne Kingston, Wilts, who died on the 3rd July last, leaving a personality valued at £11,195, has been granted to the executors, Mr. John Russ, of Collingbourne Ducis, and Mr. George Henry Gale, of Ogbourne St. George. The testator bequeaths to the Savernake Cottage Hospital £500; for such institutions for the benefit of the deaf and dumb as the executors may select, £500; for institutions for the blind, £500; to the vicar and churchwardens of Collingbourne Ducis, £200, to expend the income thereof in coals and blankets for poor persons who have attained 55 years of age; and to the vicar and churchwardens of Collingbourne Kingston for similar objects, £1,000. A board giving notice of this benefaction is to be put up in Collingbourne Church. The testator bequeaths £700 to her cousin, John Piper, £300 to her cousin Frank, £1,000 to her cousin Morris Piper, £700 for the children of her cousin Edwin, £300 to Mrs. Mary Lambden, £300 to her cousin, Miss Louise Piper, and £50 to Miss Mary Ann Russ, £50 each to the executors of the will and £15 each to two servants. All the residue of the property she leaves to Mrs. Louise Keturah Russ.
