



John Hungerford Heathcote Penruddocke

A member of an old Wiltshire family whose seat was at Compton Chamberlayne, near Wilton, Wilts, Mr. John Hungerford Heathcote Penruddocke has died at Bath following an operation. He had resided at Enleigh, Limpley Stoke for the past 15 years.

Mr. Penruddocke was a second cousin of Captain George W. Penruddocke, MC, formerly of the 3rd Battalion, Wiltshire Regiment, who a year after succeeding to the estate in 1929, sold Compton Park.

Born at Seend, Wilts, Mr. Penruddocke spent his early years there and then went to America.

His wife survives him with a son, Mr. John Hungerford Penruddocke also of Limpley Stoke.
