PRIMROSE LEAGUE ENTERTAINMENTS

A number of variety entertainments, in some respects quite unique, have recently been given at Compton Park, Salisbury, to the Associates belonging to the second sub-district of the Wilton House Habitation, by their Warden and Mr Penruddocke, assisted by their family and by kind friends. The little theatre at Compton Park was well filled each night, so that the Associates of the villages of Compton Chamberlayne, Dinton, Fovant, Hurdcott and Baverstock might all be included in their turn. The entertainment consisted both of instrumental and vocal music. – In an interval between the first and second parts of the entertainment Mr Penruddocke gave a short account of the chief events in the political world since their last meeting, and suggested that this being the Jubilee year every member of the League should do his or her best to add one or two more to their numbers. This suggestion was highly approved of. A sixth and last variety entertainment is to be given by the company at Compton Park for the Barford Association, so as to enable all in the sub-district to have their share in the amusement.
